Packets: School packets will be available at the finish line when teams arrive, We are not using bibs this year! Packets will contain a program with heat and flight assignments.

Meeting: 9:30am @ the Finish Line

Entry Fee: \$200.00 per school for both genders or \$15.00 per individual athlete until the \$200.00 limit is reached.

Meet Philosophy:

The philosophy of the meet is to provide a development platform for individuals new to the sport (Girls' Frosh & Boys' Frosh-Soph), in addition to catering for varsity level of competition. Please be aware that all events will not be offered for all levels of competition. Please refer to the attachments on athletic.net for specific events contested.

Restrictions to Meet Divisions: In order to ensure the integrity of the developmental aspect of the meet competitors that compete in the Girls' Frosh and the Boys' Frosh-Soph divisions cannot cross-over and compete in an event in the varsity section of the meet. However, if a 9th grade girl or a 9th-10th boy wants

to compete in a varsity event, they must remain in the varsity division for the entire meet and cannot compete in the Girls' Frosh or the Boys' Frosh-Soph divisions.

Parking: Please drop off teams on the north side of Zaepfel Stadium (close to Tieton Drive). Buses should then exit onto 40th Avenue (right turn only), and take the next right onto Arlington St. Buses should park on the south parking lot of the school. Please don't have buses park in the North lot, this is for spectator parking only.

Team Tents: Team tents can be placed on the North Bleachers or on the grass areas on the north and east side outside the track.

Running Events: All final results will be based on heat performance. There will be no Finals. Heats will be contested from slowest to-fastest submitted times.

Field Events: Field Events will be flighted for easier management. In the throws and jumps, there will be 3-attempts and no finals. Two different pits may be used for the Shot and Discus.

Warm-ups: Please keep the infield clear for warm-ups only. When not being used, the north side of the track may also be used.

Spike Length: ¼" or 3/16 spikes to be used on the track and horizontal jumps. On the High jump and javelin runways, 3/8" spikes may be used.

Admission: All competing athletes (dressed in school warm-ups) and coaches will be admitted free to the meet. Teams can only enter through the north entrance to Zaepfel Stadium. There will be no entrance through the south gate for teams or spectators.

Admission: Adults.....\$6.00

Credit/Debit cards will be accepted.

Team Scoring: Varsity events will be scored 10-8-6-4-2-1 for places 1st-6th. There will be no team scoring for sub-varsity divisions.

Entry Limits: 1-Relay team per school.
3-Entries per school for Varsity laned events.
3- Entries per school for individual field events.
3-Throwers/Jumpers per school for a Field Event Relay.
3-Runners per school for the distance events
2- Athletes per school may enter the Girls' Frosh and the Boys' Frosh-Soph events.

Starting Heights: Girls' Frosh High Jump....3'-8" Varsity Girls High Jump....4'-2"
Girls' Varsity Pole Vault....6'-6"
Boys' Frosh-Soph High Jump.....4'-4" Boys' Frosh-Soph PV....7'-0"
Boys' Varsity High Jump.....5'-2" Boys' Varsity PV.....9'-6"

Awards: There will be medals awarded to all winners in every event
Team trophies will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd teams.
A combined trophy will be awarded to the school that have the best accumulated score for both boys and girls.

Timing: FAT will be used for all running events. We have the best person in the region (Rob Whitacre) to handle the timing duties. Live on-line results throughout the meet through GC Racing. Lap times will be provided in the distance races. *LIVE RESULTS Online – [CLICK HERE](#)*
